Controlled Sensory Environment

Each person has 5 senses that are familiar These include Vision, Touch, Smell, Hearing, and Taste Orchard Multi-Sensory Room engages all 5 of these senses as well as 2 more less known senses Vestibular Sense is a sense that puts balance into our lives. It provides information about movement, gravity, and changing head positions. It tells us whether we are moving or staying still. The Sense of Proprioception is a sense that processes information from our muscles, joints, and other body parts to provide us with an unconscious awareness of the position of our body to other people and objects. Activities that engage our 7 senses increase resident's awareness and attention due to the simplicity of the tasks. Our specially designed sensory room enables all residents to take part regardless of their cognitive or physical deficits. The world is full of sensory stimuli. Cognitive Deficits cause some residents to not be able to organize and respond appropriately. For these residents the world becomes confusing and frightening Our Sensory room brings residents back to a place of safety, relaxation, and control
